- All modules are aligned with NAEYC's Standards for Early Childhood Preparation, Colorado's Competencies for Early Childhood Educators and Administrators, as well as the Council for Professional Recognition's Subject Areas and Competency Standards.
- Seminar:** Includes 16 additional hours of coaching support; assisting CDA Candidates with portfolio preparation, exam review, and understanding of the verification visit process.
- Dates/Times:** Tuesdays from 6:00 to 8:30 pm, beginning **September 18th and ending January 15th, 2018**, plus seminar on **Saturday January 19th and January 26th.**
